'Bo' Bohannon's presentation on journaling reaches packed house

We did a couple of exercises exploring the relationship between the senses and memory, as aids to personal scrutiny. Bo recommended reading Upton Sinclair's *The Jungle* and Jonathan Swift's *A Modest Proposal*. Bo can talk about serious things and still leave you laughing.
