1. Open submissions (no agent required) 2,500 to 5,000 words, Times New Roman, 12-point, single spaced. No break between paragraphs, set first line indent at 0.50 and spacing at Single. Previously published stories are acceptable, but state where and when published. Provide full author ID—Name, mailing address, and e-mail, and a 150-word biography. All submissions must be the property of the author, or a written release is required from the previous publisher.
2. Deadline is Oct. 31, 2025.
3. Contributors accepted will receive one free copy of the anthology as compensation. All rights returned to the authors upon publication.
